

Duration and eligibility

The certificate course in Research Methodology is of one term duration. Lectures will be conducted in one week in the month of July. Full day sessions will be conducted for 6 working days. The course is open to PhD students and even to those who want to register for PhD. The student has to appear for the written examination and give a presentation at the end of the course.

Important dates (Tentative):

- Last date to pay the fees (For outside students): 20th July 2019
- Dates for the lectures: (Time 10.30 am to 5.30 pm) During 22nd to 31st July (any 6 working days)
- Exam and presentations last week of December 2019

Eligibility

- Post-graduate degree in any discipline amongst Ancient Indian History, Culture and Archeology, Linguistics and Sanskrit and Lexicography.

Note:

- The degree should be as specified by and of a University / Institute approved by the University Grants Commission / Association of Indian Universities.

Admission procedure

Fee Structure

No tuition and exam fees will be charged for the PhD students of Deccan College (Those who have registered for PhD with Deccan College)

Outside students will be charged Rs.5000/- as the fees for the one term course. This includes the tuition fees and exam fees for the course.

Registration fee Rs.500 should be paid by all the students in cash on the first day of lectures at the time registration (Course kit will be provided along with the

syllabus).Library facility will be provided to the outside students as per the university library rules.

How to apply

The students can fill up the forms available online on the website of the University. Outside students should pay the fees and then fill the form as they have to give the payment details in the form. (form fees Rs.50 will be charged at the time of form submission)

- Application incomplete in any sense will not be considered for admission
- If the final degree examination result is not declared the candidate shall submit statement of marks of previous year (First year) MastersExamination mark sheet.
- Admission to a course will initially remain provisional. It will be confirmed when all the documents specified below are submitted and accepted at the time of registration. A notice for the submission of eligibility application alongwith the below mentioned documents will be issued after the provisional admission process is over. Failure to submit the documents then will be viewed seriously by the authorities and action will be taken as per rules against the defaulting student.

List of enclosures:

- ✓ Mark-list of the last qualifying examination.
- ✓ Degree / Passing certificate of the last qualifying exam.
- ✓ A letter of confirmation of the admission will be issued to the candidate after all the documents specified in (b) above have been submitted, verified and found in order.

Exam structure/ assessment process

A minimum of 75 percent attendance at lectures and completion of assignments will be necessary for qualifying to appear for the examination. Examination will be conducted at the end of the one term course.

The University Examination will consist of a written test of 20 marks and presentation of 80 marks. The student has to give a presentation on a fresh topic. This presentation will be judged by the external subject experts.

Terms of Passing

To be eligible to pass in the examination of the course a student should secure minimum passing percentage of 50% i.e. 50 marks out of 100 marks
